



## **Wavepower 2016 – 19: The ASA Child Safeguarding Policy & Procedures**

Wavepower 2016-19 is the Amateur Swimming Association (ASA) Child Safeguarding Policies and Procedures publication. It has been produced to assist in safeguarding and protecting children in the sport of swimming and must be adopted by all ASA affiliated clubs and organisations.

While the ASA is confident the majority of its clubs, and specifically those with a swim21 accreditation have very good, proactive, child welfare policies, they acknowledge that sometimes problems can develop that require action. To ensure that parents feel reassured that the club is a safe environment for them to leave their child or young person, Wavepower provides some guidance.
