### 1. Welcome & Chairman's Report

## Update and Plans for the future: Louise Croft Baker-

TSC Chairman, Louise (LCB) opened the meeting and welcomed everyone. Power point presentation shown highlighting Club's vision, club development and objectives. Strong focus on welfare of our swimmers with highlighting Helen Burton taking over the role as the new Welfare Officer and when to contact her. ## 2. Treasurer's Report – Kate Rampley:

The Treasurer, Kate Rampley (KR), presented her annual report for year ended 31<sup>st</sup> March 2023.

A new club structure has been set up to ensure the future of the club after the head coach retiring. This will enable us to succession plan should Mark and Damian step down. Mark and Damian are both volunteers. Despite increasing costs, TSC has managed to increase it's reserves up to £42,678 (Please see Power point Presentation for full breakdown of figures). The club is committed to ongoing support of coached development and investment in club equipment.

KR reported that going forward pool hire charges were due to rise again so we would monitor fees going forward.

## 3. Head Coach's Report: Mark Simms

Mark Simms (MS) reported that the Club had achieved a lot over the last year- exceeding all his personal goals.

The groups are nearly full with nearly 15% increased since the last AGM.

We had swimmers make finals and medal in this years ONB counties which gave the club it highest points score for many years, well done to those swimmers.

We also had had 3 swimmers gain entry time this year for the Southeast region swim galas, Clara and Bonnie White and Ruthie Galloway.

All had great swims gaining long course PB's with Ruthie making the finals in her age group 100 and 200 back stroke events.



Future:- The future looks bright for TSC with English nationals coming soon.

We have our club championships in September as well as many more Galas to follow.

We have a Swim Camp in October.
